The Hiram Hubbard House

4RiverValleys Historical Society has accepted from Linda and Peter Rogers the title to the Historic Hiram Hubbard House in Champion, New York. The hope of 4RVHS is to bring this circa 1800 grey limestone house to a semblance of its former elegance.

The house will eventually become the home base for 4RVHS with meeting rooms, research and reference material library, historic exhibits, a gift shop and education areas. It is hoped that in the not too distant future, workshops can be held here in areas of local interest

This process will require the time and effort of many people within the community; a process as old as or older than the house itself – neighbor working beside neighbor to accomplish a goal that will benefit everyone. There are many types of talent that are needed: from basic cleaning, painting, papering, and glazing to yard work that could include the reintroduction of period flowers, herbs and a kitchen garden.
