Rochester’s famous Lilac Festival is a lavish array of flowers, attractions and special events that mark the arrival of Spring.

After a stop for lunch we will arrive at **Highland Park**, the site of the Lilac Festival. Here, we will be guided through the many gardens loaded with spring flowers and enjoy the fragrant aroma of the thousands of lilac blooms.

The 1,200 plus lilac in Highland Park create a floral rainbow ranging from the deepest purples to the purest of white to make this the largest celebration of its kind in North America.

More than 100 artists, crafters, and exhibitors will be on hand for this year’s Arts and Crafts show with an emphasis on handmade gifts and crafts.

Then our local guide will take us on a **tour of the city** which will highlight such sights as the **High Falls/Brown’s Race Historic District** with its 96-foot Falls that was used to power Rochester when it was the centre of the flour industry, the historical, cultural and recreational areas. After a delightful time in Rochester, we will depart for home with a stop for dinner at **The Colorado Mine Co, Steakhouse included in the tour**.
